December is the month where we bless our students!

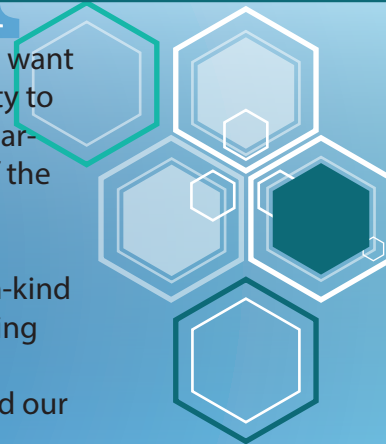
