## LANCE AMARANTE


“ My name is Lance. I came to Teen Challenge when I found myself addicted to alcohol and I couldn't overcome it on my own. One 30-day program and several attempts to free myself from my addiction were always short lived. I could never make it more than six months clean.



This addiction developed slowly. It all started when I was blindsided by a divorce from my wife of ten years. We had two boys, ages 5 and 7. Losing my family and my home, literally in one day, was devastating. I was in disbelief and numb to what had taken place in my life when it had seemed to be going so well.

When I reflect back on my life, God has truly blessed me my whole life. Now I have been given a second chance at life and I am so thankful that now I'm living my life according to God's will for me. I give him all the praise and glory for everything he has done for me and continues to do for me and my family and for others who come to Teen Challenge with the hope of a new life and restoration of their relationships with their families and with God.
