

Every year we have such high hopes for our ministry's vision of bringing hope to men, women, and families struggling with life controlling issues. Unfortunately none of us could imagine over a year ago, we would be forced to cancel most of our income generating enterprises and all of our fundraising events. However in the midst of our struggle God provided an exciting opportunity to create and host our first annual Adult & Teen Challenge Faith Home Network Ball Drop. Our biggest challenge was to find a helicopter. At our ministry we continue to learn how we serve an amazing God, and through his provision Sheriff Jeff Dirkse of the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department stepped forward to meet that need and provide not only their helicopter, but their flight crew as well. When I think about this I am reminded of God's scripture Nahum 1:7 The LORD is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him

Our goal was to sell 2500 balls and drop them from the Sheriff's helicopter on to our "Target Green" built on the softball field of our 37-acre ranch residential facility. We held a virtual event that was streamed live on Facebook, November 7th of last year. We all marveled at the participation and the events which occurred that day. The event was a "HUGE" success and we sold over 2700 balls and earned close to \$70,000. We offered gift card prizes to 11 winners totaling \$2500 and \$1000 Amazon gift card as the "grand prize." We are so thankful to all of our supporters and especially to all of you who helped make that day possible.

We have decided to host this event for the next 5 years as long as our partners are able. **This year's event will be held Saturday, November 6th** at our Ranch & Facility Headquarters in Ceres. We are in the planning stages and hope to open our facility to families, supporters, sponsors, and food trucks for a wonderful day of fellowship, food, & fun. We hope you will be able to bring the "little-ones" out to encounter the helicopter and possibly be thrilled by meeting the pilot and of course

sitting in the chopper. **This year we have a goal of \$100,000** and hope to have a live event with over 200 attendees.
